

NRPF service provision – at a glance

Referral

- How do people with NRPF approach the Council?
- Are all potential access points aware of the support options for people with NRPF?
- Do referral/ screening forms ask questions about nationality & immigration status?

Screening

- What is the person's nationality and immigration status?
- Can the person access mainstream benefits or Home Office asylum support? - **chapters 2 & 16**
- Will the Schedule 3 exclusion apply to the person or family? - **chapter 7**
- Does housing/ financial support need to be provided to meet urgent need whilst undertaking assessments? - **chapter 5**

Eligibility

- Families - GIRFEC assessment - **chapter 8**
- Adults - Community care assessment - **chapter 9**
- Young people leaving care - aftercare duties - **chapter 10**
- Human rights assessment - when the Schedule 3 exclusion applies to the parent, adult or young person (18+) - **chapter 11**

Support

- Accommodation
- Financial support - in line with any internal guidance
- Care package (adults)
- Services to meet child's additional needs
- Help accessing immigration advice - **chapter 13**
- Help accessing employment, education or training
- Working in partnership with legal representative, Home Office etc.

Resolution

- Pathways out of dependency on support - **chapter 13**
- Change in immigration status that confers recourse to public funds
- Employment - self-sufficiency
- Home Office asylum support
- Return to country of origin
