## **Review checklist**

This checklist is designed to act as a prompt for additional considerations that may need to be made when a review of an NRPF household receiving support from the local authority is carried out. Reviews should be conducted regularly, within a timeframe that is appropriate to the identified needs of the individual/ family and has regard to the prospect of any material change in their situation, for example, legal developments or factors affecting their welfare.
